Please do NOT bring:

Sandals or open-toed shoes, radios, cell phones, tape or CD players, headsets, ipods, electronic games (i.e., Giga Pets, Game Boys, etc.), gum or snacks. No food may be kept in cabins.

◆ Activities:

We plan a wide variety of activities for you to choose from. **A few weeks before camp you'll receive a list of all the camp activities offered so that you can sign up in advance.** The size of the activity groups is limited and they are available on a first-come, first-served basis.

◆ Tuck Shop:

Tuck Shop is our camp store and is one of the ways we can subsidize our camp program cost so that it is not part of our camp registration fees. We have T-shirts, stationery, stamps, stuffed animals, lots of gifts and other fun things for sale each day. Snacks, soft drinks and juice are also available to buy. Your money will be turned in at registration time and banked in your Tuck Shop account for you to use each day. The money you have left in your account will be returned to you when you check out of camp at the end of your stay. No money is to be kept in cabins.

◆ Registration: Please do not plan to arrive before 2 pm for check-in/registration.

GIRLS: Check in time at begins at 2:00 p.m. and continues till 4:00 p.m. on Sunday, July 4. . **The camp week ends promptly at 10:00 a.m. the following Saturday, July 10.**

BOYS: Check in time is from 2:00 pm until 4:00 pm on Saturday, July 10. **Camp ends promptly at 10:00 am on Wednesday, July 14.**

◆ Closing Program

We will be having a short closing program to end our week of camp. Parents may join us at 9:30 am in Memorial Hall on the last day of camp for a short program recapping the exciting events.

◆ Directions to Tonto Rim Camp:

Take the Beeline Highway 87 to Payson. Turn east onto Highway 260 and go about 17 miles to Tonto Creek Recreation Area turn. Go about 2 miles to Tonto Rim Camp. A detailed map will come in the activity packet a few weeks before camp.

◆ Mail:

Campers love to get mail, so send your letters early. But please, no food packages. Information regarding sending emails to your camper will be coming in your camper's activity packet a few weeks before camp.

◆ Parent Questionnaire, Camper Release Form & Consent for Transportation Form:

The **Parent Questionnaire**, to be filled out by a parent or guardian, will be of tremendous help to your camper's counselor and the staff who will be working with him/her. This confidential information will help us provide the best possible camping experience for your camper. **The Camper Release Form** must be filled out with the name of the individual(s) who will picking up your camper. Be sure to complete, SIGN and return the enclosed Consent for Transportation Form.

◆ Medical Form:

The Health History/Examination Form must be filled out in its entirety in order for your camper to be admitted to camp. Please be sure to fill in all immunization dates and to sign this form. The Health Examination portion of this form is recommended, but not required. If your camper requires prescription medicine, please bring it in its pharmacy-labeled container with the camper's name and dosage information clearly noted. All medication will be kept in the infirmary and dispensed by the camp nurse. No medicine of any kind can be left in cabins. Most over-the-counter medicines such as aspirin, Tylenol, Pepto Bismol, etc., are provided by the camp.

◆ Health, Safety Standards:

Every precaution is taken to assure that your child remains healthy and safe while at camp. Staff members are well trained in safety awareness and emergency procedures. A registered nurse is at camp at all times. Activities are led by appropriately trained or certified instructors. Meals are well balanced and reviewed by a nutritionist. Our camp is inspected by the American Camp Association (ACA) and meets their high standards.

◆ Balance of Camp Fee: The balance of the camp fee is due before camp begins.
